ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be current members of the NYSSRS, Inc. in good standing (Rad Tech, Rad Therapy and Nuclear Medicine students).
2. **Proof of NYSSRS membership must be submitted with the signed submission form.**
3. Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited Radiography, Radiation Therapy or Nuclear Medicine program.

ENTRY FEE

There will **not be any entry fee to enter** the Student Poster Competition.

THEME

The theme for this year's poster competition is **"The Production of Scatter Radiation"**. Posters will be on display during the NYSSRS conference November 6&7, 2020. The winner will be announced after the student bowl competition. You can either make the poster board or purchase a three-sided board (available at any craft or office supply stores). Your poster must tell about the ionizing modality/modalities you are highlighting and hold the interest of the viewer. The title and headings should be neat and large enough to read at a distance of 3 feet. Creativity is encouraged.
