ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be current members of the NYSSRS, Inc. in good standing (Radiologic Technology or Nuclear Medicine students).
2. **Proof of NYSSRS membership must be submitted with the signed submission form.**
3. Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited radiography or radiation therapy program.

ENTRY FEE

There will **not be any entry fee** to enter the Student Poster Competition.

THEME

The theme for this year's poster competition is "**Interventional Radiology: Disorders, Imaging, and Therapies**". Posters will be on display during the NYSSRS conference in October 21 - 23, 2021. The winner will be announced after the student bowl competition. You can either make the poster board or purchase a three-sided board (available at any craft or office supply stores). Your poster must tell about study(s) you are highlighting and hold the interest of the viewer. The title and headings should be neat and large enough to read at a distance of 3 feet. Creativity is encouraged.

May include: This is a suggestion list; all items are not required. Be creative with your topic!

- ❖ Definitions of various interventional studies and therapies
- ❖ Use of CT, MRI and other modalities
- ❖ How equipment manufacturers are making improvements in interventional imaging equipment
- ❖ Choose a particular interventional study and the most common pathology associated with it
- ❖ Discuss details of the technologist's role in the procedure, therapeutic applications, specialized equipment

Judgment Criteria:

- ❖ Topic Range and Relevance
- ❖ Organization and Mechanics (logic, grammar, clarity, neatness)
- ❖ Aesthetic look
- ❖ Value & Interest
- ❖ Creativity
